What does Cameo offer?

CAMEO provides small, self contained day centres offering respite to carers looking after a confused person.

Amongst services available on a regular basis are the following:

- Outings
- Stimulating activities including:
 - art and craft
 - reminiscence
 - music
- Companionship
- Lunch, tea and coffee
- Support for carers
- Advice on other help which may be available

What does Cameo offer?

We have excellent day centres throughout Spelthorne that cater for more able people. For those who are confused, a small group that offers a high ratio of staff and volunteer helpers to members, means they receive the stimulation and attention they need. It also ensures that their carers receive much needed respite

Who runs Cameo?

Cameo, a registered charity, is run by paid managers, activity support workers, and a team of volunteers, who report to an independent management committee. A close working relationship is maintained with Social Services, the Older Person's Mental Health Team and the Health Authority.
